

**HAMLIN TOWNSHIP  
REQUEST FOR BIDS**

Hamlin Township is accepting sealed bids to repair/reconstruct a wall and railing at the Hamlin Township Transfer Site, 6565 W. Dewey Road, Ludington.

**Treated Wood Railing:**

Bid on removal and reconstruction of a new treated wood railing, with new 4 X 6 post placed 8 foot apart and a 2 X 8 top cap, 2 X 6 stringers and 2 X 4 vertical spindles placed not more an 4" apart. .

The overall length of the railing is 120' feet. Height of the railing needs to be 3' foot high.

**Retaining Wall**

Bid on construction of a new retaining wall using pre-cast concrete interlocking blocks 2' X 2' X 6'. (They are approximately 3,000 lb. each) following the height and length of the existing wall directly in front of the existing retaining wall. Set pre-cast interlocking concrete blocks on 4" of crushed concrete or crushed limestone. Back-fill between pre-cast interlocking blocks and existing retaining wall if needed.

\*Provide a Certificate of Liability Insurance in bid package. Contractor shall be classified as an Independent Contractor and shall assume liability.

\*Provide estimate time of job with approximate start date.

\*Contractor shall furnish all labor, equipment, and materials necessary to perform all work for construction of this project.

\*Inspection of the Retaining Wall can be viewed on Monday, Wednesday and Saturdays' from 10 a.m., to 6:00 p.m. at the Hamlin Township Transfer Site until September 30, 2021. After September 30<sup>th</sup>, the Transfer Site will be open from 9 a.m. to 5:00 p.m., on Monday, Wednesday's and Saturdays. If you are unable to inspect during those hours, please contact Nancy Vandervest, Township Supervisor at 231-845-7801 Ext. 2.

\*Sealed Bids due to Hamlin Township, 3775 N. Jebavy Drive, Ludington, MI 49431 by 4:30 p.m. on October 13, 2021. Mark envelope "Transfer Site Bid".

\*The work shall be done in an attractive manner, left in a neat area free from any debris with removal of the old wall and rail be removed off premises.

\*Bids will be opened on Thursday, October 14, 2021 at the Hamlin Township Board of Trustees Meeting which begins at 6:00 p.m.
